House Bill No 1574 will affect the COG if it is passed a motion was made that a letter would be drafted and then sent to all municipalities to sign and send in to stop the passing of this bill.

There wasn't anyone interested in going to the PA COG conference in September.

I need to call Phil from Chemung again to see if he has anything new for us on the price of blanks.

Another bill that we need to write about is the State Police Protection it will cost each municipality in three years about 1 million dollars. This is money that we cannot afford to spend. I will draft a letter and send a copy to each municipality to fill out and send in stating that we do not want this bill to pass.

They talked about the storm water management being forced back on the municipalities that Penn Dot no longer holds them responsible for the up keep or management of the drains and pipes.

The Energy Task Force took a bus trip around Bradford County to see the wells that are going in.
