The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by COG President, Scot Sample.

Linwood Myers made a motion to except the May minutes and Carl Rine JR seconded the motion it was put to a vote all were in favor of approving the minutes soothe motion was carried.

Bill Stasiak made a motion to except the treasurers' report and Fred Jugan seconded Bob Getz asked one quick question about the 118.78 that is still owed to the COG from Code Inspections. It was a mistake on the paper work from Code that caused our check to be short this much and they are going to have a second check issued to us for this amount. After the discussion on this it was put to a vote and all approved of the motion to except the treasurers' report.

Bob Getz stated some information that was given at the Task Force meeting. If a gas company will be using a road for a number of years they will redo the road so that they are suitable for them to be traveling on them. Also they are following up on companies and making sure that permits are being used.

Bob Getz also stated that the pads are bigger than first expected the least on so far used 8 acres of land with up to 11 acres of disturbance of land.

WE asked Bob Getz how he felt the Government Day went and he stated that it went well they had 33 agencies there. From Scot Sample being there to promote the 911 signs we have to date received 11 orders do to attending the government day.

Tim Brown talked about the prices on pipe and signs he stated that Chemung had lower prices on the pipes and Bradco on signs and post. He stated that neither had any problem making out separate bills for each municipality. So the question was asked if it would be okay to order the pipes from one company and the signs and post from the other. Carl Vough though it would be okay to split the orders and Carl Rine JR seconded the motion Scot asked for a vote and all approved of separating the orders to get a better deal.

Clara was given permission to order some sign blanks.

Tim Brown made a motion for the bills to be paid and Fred Jugan seconded the motion it was put to a vote and all voted to pay the bills.

Paul Stanley asked if anyone could help him out on how to go about replacing a bridge with a steel arch. Bob Getz suggested maybe they could look into a military bridge and then he also suggested that he call Rich Biery.

Bob Getz stated that one bridge in Hillsgrove took 9 years to have it fixed he also stated that the bridge in Sonestown needs 2 timbers to have it fixed.
